Endo or Implant: Making Intelligent Treatment Decisions

Dr. Reza Farshey received his Bachelors degree in Physics in 1994 from McGill University. He then moved to Boston to study dentistry, and received his dental degree from Tufts University in 1998. After completing a one year general practice residency at Berkshire Medical Center, he went on to maintain a successful restorative practice for the next 7 years. He completed his endodontic specialty training at Boston University in 2007, and has been practicing in the Washington metropolitan area ever since. Dr. Farshey has a strong interest in endodontic education. He actively lectures for numerous local and regional study clubs, as well as for Tulsa Dental Specialties. Most recently, Dr. Farshey co-authored an article for the European journal Premium Practice Dentistry, entitled "Endodontic Diagnosis: The Third Dimension".

The advent of dental implants has significantly improved the quality of dental care rendered. However, in the last decade an increasing trend has been observed, where compromised (but restorable) teeth are extracted in favor of dental implants. The rationale behind these decisions are often based on misguided or biased information. This lecture provides an objective and evidence-based approach in comparing the success rate of the endodontically-treated tooth and the dental implant.
